Eucharistic Pilgrimage – May 17-18 in Bemidji



Knights Sponsoring Novena for Life – May 4th – May 12^{th.}

The Waconia Knights are leading a pro-life program called Novena for Life. A novena is a period of sustained prayer over nine days for a particular intention.
