10th National Eucharistic Congress – Indianapolis

On July 17-21, I was able to attend the National Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis, Indiana. This was the first Eucharistic Congress in 83 years, and it was the most powerful event I have ever experienced in my lifetime. 60,000 Catholics gathered in Indianapolis for this generational event, and countless more across the nation joined via livestream.

Each morning, we attended Impact Sessions tailored to our own personal mission and state in life—brought together by some of the most trusted voices in the Church with compelling topics for adult Catholics, youth, ministry leaders, and families. The Holy Sacrifice of the Mass was celebrated in multiple rites and languages witnessing the impact of our Catholic Faith through many different cultures.

Congress attendees gathered in Lucas Oil Stadium each evening for a special revival session and Adoration, where together we worshipped Our Lord, heard the Gospel message, experienced healing, and were unified by the shared mission to make Jesus known and loved. The event was capped off by a Eucharistic Procession where thousands of Catholics walked alongside our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament through the streets of downtown Indianapolis—publicly professing our faith and witnessing to the world that Jesus is a King worth following. Truly one of the most emotional and moving events of the weekend. It was truly an event I will never forget!
